SCHOOL BOARD VOTES \$600 FOR SANITATION

Work of Modernizing Systems in 39 Units in County Gets Under Way

The County School Board, meeting Tuesday, with all members present, appropriated \$600 to be expended in sanitation work in the schools of the county. A recent survey made by the county sanitation officer, under the authority of the State Board of Health, disclosed sewage disposal systems in 39 school to be unsatisfactory. Work of installing modern sanitary systems in these schools is now under way.

Superintendent O. L. Emerick reported to the board receipt of a letter from the State Board of Health advising that the state authorities could not furnish typhoid vaccine free, but could obtain a supply from manufacturers. The Loudoun Medical Society recently advised that all persons in the county be vaccinated against typhoid.

The board went on record as disapproving the use of the schools for collecting money to aid in the purchase of "Wakefield," birthplace of George Washington, taking the view that the time is inappropriate for such collections.

The superintendent was authorized to employ an additional teacher at Phillmont on a half-day basis.

Attendance in the schools during September was 339 in excess of the number reported for September, 1929, Superintendent Emerick reported to the board. No action was taken on the requests for a school for colored children at Bycolline, for an additional teacher at Lucketts and for a full-day school at Clarks Gap.
