APPLICATION FOR A LOAN FROM THE LITERARY FUND

Name of County or City Loudoun Name of School Lovettsville

To the State Board of Education,
Richmond, Virginia.

Gentlemen:

The school board for the county or city of Loudoun hereby makes application for a loan from the Literary Fund of \$11,000⁰⁰ for the purpose of erecting or enlarging the school building at Lovettsville

The said building or addition is to be of (brick or frame) construction, with 4 rooms according to plans and specifications approved by the Superintendent of Public Instruction, and estimated to cost \$15,000⁰⁰.

Total value of the school building including site, and the proposed addition thereto is estimated at \$60,000.

The actual amount of the loan will be based upon the total cost of the building when completed, and will not be in excess of two-thirds of the actual cost of the building; said two-thirds not to exceed fifty thousand dollars.

The plans and specifications for the building or improvement have been approved by the division superintendent of schools and the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

It is desirable to make the proposed improvement because:

The present indebtedness of the County or City for school buildings is \$ 127,851 of which \$ 7851 is owed to the Literary fund.

The Board of Supervisors for the county or the Council for the city, has by a resolution hereto attached, provided for the funds to pay this loan.

Last year's income of the county or city for school purposes was \$ 125,000.

It is understood that the State Board of Education reserves the right to withhold any part or all of the amount of this loan, if the plans and specifications approved by the Superintendent of Public Instruction are not strictly followed.

This loan is to run for 20 years and bear interest at four percent per annum payable semi-
(from 5 to 30 yrs)

annually. The loan is to be repaid in 20 annual installments.

WHEREAS, The School Board for the county of Loudoun
or city of _____, on the 18th day of June, 1937,
presented to this Board or Council, an application addressed to the State Board of Education of Virginia, for the
purpose of borrowing from the Literary Fund \$ 11,000 for the new school building (or for adding to
or remodeling the present school building) at Lorettsville, to be repaid
in 20 annual installments, and the interest thereon paid semi-annually.

RESOLVED, That the application of the county or city School Board to the State Board of Education of
Virginia, for a loan of \$ 11,000 from the Literary Fund, is hereby approved, and authority is hereby
granted the said county or city School Board to borrow the said amount for the purpose set out in said applica-
tion.

The Board of Supervisors for said county or Council for said city will each year during the life of this loan,
at the time they fix the regular levies, fix a rate of levy for schools or make a cash appropriation sufficient for
operation expenses and to repay this loan in annual installments, and the interest thereon, as required by law regu-
lating loans from the Literary Fund.
