The 400 acres tract of land, represented by the above plat, is the tract on which Mr. David James now lives; and which was allotted to him, by the Commissioners in the division of his father's estate, and is bounded as follows. Beginning at A. a large Stone, placed in the original line of Ball's patent, and also corner to Harrison Coop; thence S 47° 12' E 32 poles, along the S. line of Ball's patent to B. a stone placed by the side of a fence; thence N 32° 24' E at 80 poles crossed the old Alexandria road, same course continued in all 101 poles to C. planted a stone; thence S 69° E at 20 poles crossed pine branch, continued same course in all 47 poles & 5 links to D. a white oak on the edge of an old road, anciently marked as a corner; and said to be corner to Mr. James; thence S 15° E 7 1/2 poles to E. a stone placed

this tract & Aaron James's lot; thence S 58° 11' E 244 poles to F. a stone planted in the line of the land of Daniel Kimbler, around which is one Box, & 2 red oak saplings, marked as pointers, which is also corner to Bail's Holeys lot; thence with Kimbler's line S 58° 11' E 8 poles to G. a red oak sapling corner to Kimbler & Palmers; thence with Palmers line S 69° W 81 poles to H. a peach tree, thence S 23° W 11 poles & 15 links to I. a persimmon bush on the north edge of the old Alexandria road; thence along S. road S 57° E 37 poles & 15 links to K. a stone planted on the north edge of S. road & corner to S. Kimbler; thence with his line S 64° W 29 poles & 5 links to L. a stone on the west edge of the mill road; thence along said road S 2° W 198 poles & 13 links to M. another stone, corner to Kimbler & Buckner; thence with Buckner's line S 84° 15' W (at 24 poles crossed pine branch) in all 66 poles to N. a stump in S. road, corner to Buckner & Coop; thence N 57° W 66 poles to A. containing 400 acres.
