Beginning at (1), a set stone, corner of Minnie Furr thence along line of Granville Stewart S 85-30 E 34.0 feet to (2), an iron pin, thence along line of Granville Stewart N 5-30 W 288.0 feet to (3), thence along line of Rebecca Hoopes S 85-30 E 408.0 feet to (4), an iron pin, thence along line of Rebecca Hoopes S 8-E, 287.0 feet to (5), thence along line of Rebecca Hoopes S 84-E 189 feet to (6), a stone thence along line of Shirley Payne S 6-E 524.0 feet to (7), thence along line of Ray Stewart N 85-W 150.5 feet to (8), an iron pin thence along line of Levi Johnson N 6-W 223.0 feet to (9), thence along line of Levi Johnson N 84-30-W 220.0 feet to (10), thence along line Loudoun County Emancipation Association N 6-W 218.5 feet to (11), a stone, thence along line of Loudoun County Emancipation^{Association} S 67-30-W 289.0 feet to (12), thence along line of Minnie Furr N 4 -W 208.5 feet to (1), the point of beginning, containing 6.848 A more or less.
