1. Latitude 39° 10' measures about twelve inches from top on right and should be this on left.
2. Show a decided gap in Short Hill at Hillsboro where creek goes through.

Everything else is O. K. I am inclosing warrant to pay for this part of the work and you can turn this over to the firm.

After you make these two corrections let the map be made without more proof-reading by me. Use the colors on last map, namely:- Broad Run, purple; Leesburg, green, Lovettsville, yellow, Jefferson, blue, Mt. Gilead pink, and Mercer Buff.

I am not inclosing any of the prints now as I judge you do not need them.
