I had no idea when you made request for sample of heavier paper that it would take so long, or develop into so complex a question. The trouble has been that dealers have quoted exorbitant prices, owing to the small quantity wanted.

Enclose a sample of excellent map paper that is for the printing, of course its for you to decide as to the weight.

The cost for this paper will increase the cost but \$20. on the completed map, from \$540.00 to ^{\$575⁰⁰} \$560.00 as per estimate.

I have arrived at a point in the making of your map that I would like to have you call at your convenience, and both inspect what has been done, and offer any suggestions, and decide on some minor questions that have developed.

After the completion of drawing, which I think will take about a week after you call, I will submit blue prints of your map for your thorough examination, ^o corrections and changes, and after the paper question is settled, the printing of map will proceed quickly to completion.
