The vaccination of school children against poliomyelitis will take place at the Health Department, Leesburg, on Tuesday, April 27 and at the Health Center, Middleburg, on Wednesday, April 28. It is requested that the use of school busses for transportation of children to the clinics be authorized. Also I should like to leave to you all arrangement in connection with bus schedules. It is desired that the second grade children be accompanied by the teachers. At each school several mothers have volunteered to assist in the management of children at the clinics and it is desired that they accompany the children on the busses.

I have been told that the vaccine will be delivered to me Sunday afternoon or Monday morning, next. The vaccination schedule as it has been set us is enclosed. If rearrangement is necessary because of transportation, such can be made. However I would like to notify the schools as to the schedule at the earliest possible moment. If the vaccine should not arrive as planned it will be necessary to change this schedule.

The same schedule of vaccination will be set up for the second series on May 4th. and 5th. and for the third series on June 1st. and 2nd.
