I am sending in my bill for the transportation of my daughter Ruth Elizabeth Williams to the Loudoun High school, for the year, 38-39 and the year 39- 40 .She is transported by the Washington- and Old Dominion railway. The fare per month is \$6.70. IN April 1939 she was sick and I received from the railway company a re- fund of \$3.80. And in November, 1939 she was sick again and I re- ceived a refund of \$4.65 following is a complete outline of the bill.
