The information on the inclosed sheet of paper is something I dug out the report of 1938-39 just for my own interest. It shows just how many more colored teachers than white teachers.

I notice that Greensville County has more colored teachers than white teachers. The average salary of colored teachers was \$368.00 less than the white teachers in 1939. They have a thousand more colored children than white children in this county.

Mecklenburg County has 3259 white children 3800 colored children, but one less colored teacher than white teacher.

Misery loves company. We do not have all the problems in the world.
