Dear Sirs:

The Loudoun County Teachers Association on the above date went on record and reconsidered its former action, resulting in a letter to you in which proposal was advanced for equalization of salaries for colored and white teachers.

Please be advised that this action resulted in rendering the said proposal of the said letter null and void.

Please be advised further, that the Loudoun County Teachers Association has adopted a resolution to accept literally the Proposal suggested by the Superintendent and school board pertaining to equalization of salaries, according to the five (5) sections contained in your said resolution:—

- a. "In 1941-42 pay colored teachers 11 months on the present schedule and in the event of any increase in the salaries of white teachers a corresponding additional increase in the salaries of colored teachers shall be made."
