It was decided first, after discussion, that the
library would be placed at Carver School since there
was adequate storage space on the shelves in the office
and since that location was convenient. Mr. Drummond,
Mr. Ewing, and Mrs. Schulke will help to distribute the
books when needed by various schools.

third, Mrs. Lola H. Jackson, fourth, Mrs. Flossie S. Furr,
fifth, Mr. John R. Pendleton, sixth, and Mr. Fred E.
Drummond, Jr., seventh. In the primary grades the two
series should be on an easy level and an advanced level.

After the teachers in the eight schools have been
contacted, the selections are to be made and turned in to
Mrs. Schulke who will work out the details of the order
and report it to Miss Ruth L. Americk, Clerk.

LIBRARY GUIDE READY

REVISION OF 1949 BOOK
LIST UNDER CONSIDERA-
TION.

There have been a number of requests for a new edition of the bibliography published in 1949 entitled List of Books Suggested for First Purchase for Virginia Elementary Schools. Since this list includes only "starred" or books suggested for first purchase, many schools have gone beyond this selection in the purchase of books. It would be helpful to know how the librarians feel about the possibility

1956 LIBRARY ORDER
LISTS HAVE BEEN REVISED.

The publishers' library order lists for Virginia Public Schools have undergone the annual revision and the 1956 packages of catalogs will be shipped to the office of Division Superintendents during the early part of April. The 1956 lists include 715 new elementary titles and 627 new high school titles. Also, a large number of new adult and professional books have been added. 75 publishers have printed lists for 1956 and 90 are represented on the mimeographed supplement. The 1956 packet includes printed lists for Gregg, Birchard, and Encyclopedia Britannica Films which are new additions this year.

"TRICKS OF THE TRADE" - No. 2 *

(The following are ideas taken from the Annual Library Reports submitted by Virginia School Librarians, June 1955)

I. Project in Reading Guidance

Using as a basis the Iowa Reading Tests scores and interviews with pupils and teachers, a file of all pupils' reading levels and abilities was organized. A companion file of reading interests and vocabulary levels was made of 200 books. By working with classroom teachers, the pupils and books were "brought together." Children were guided in the reading of books with words they could read and understand and subject matter that appealed to their interest.

II. Plan to Decrease Number of Overdue Books

In order to decrease the number of overdue library books, each home room selects a responsible pupil to serve as room librarian. The librarian keeps this room representative informed each day of those in his room who have books checked out and when they will be due. Each morning during home room period he reminds the pupils who have books that are to be returned to the library on that day. This plan has resulted in drastic reduction of overdues.

III. Monthly Library Bulletin

A monthly bulletin or newsletter prepared by the librarian for faculty and pupils has resulted in increased use of the library as well as closer relationship on the part of the faculty with library activities. The newsletter is a single page, mimeographed sheet, with an eye-catching title and simple illustration in the upper right hand corner. It carries such news items as (1) Announcement of new books, (2) Assembly programs, (3) Community activities associated with library service, (4) References to special magazine articles, (5) Calendar of events that the library sponsors, etc.

IV. Time-Saver in Processing Books

From experience, it has been found that it isn't necessary to wait for the arrival of a book order to start the procedure of processing. Between the time when the books are ordered and received, the following processing may be done: (1) Assign a classification number on the order card or work slip. (You may be doubtful about certain ones that you do not find in the Wilson Catalogs - hold these slips until books arrive), (2) Type book pockets and cards, (3) Assign subject headings on work slips. It is better to wait until book actually arrives before accessioning, because sometimes substitute titles have to be ordered. By getting these steps completed before the book order is received, makes it possible for the new books to be ready for the pupils in much less time.

V. Conference With Pupils

A ten to fifteen minute scheduled conference with each pupil every two months results in many worthwhile outcomes. The pupil and the librarian discuss a book or books which the pupil has read recently. The pupil's reaction to characters, style, illustrations, plot, etc. are encouraged by a friendly conversation of questions and answers. The librarian makes suggestions for further reading. By working with the classroom teachers these discussions may count as a book report for the pupil.

VI. Miscellaneous

1. Use of plastic book jackets results in increased circulation and preserves the new appearance of the book.

2. A librarian reports that she enjoys her three-quarter hour period in her library in the morning before school officially opens. "The students enjoy this free period when we all get to know each other better."
