Transportation Information

Bus routes and schedules will be the same as last year except for the following authorized changes.

Bus No. 11 driven by Mr. John Terminella will turn right from Rt. 73h on Rt. 611 and follow south to Rt. 733, turn around and follow Rt. 611 and Rt. 690 to the Purcellville School and continue as before.

Bus No. 13 driven by Mr. George Shaffer to Upperville will turn left at Blakely Grove cross roads, and follow Rt. 7h3, turn right on Rt. 623, and right on Rt. 50 to Upperville School.

Bus No. 9 driven by Mr. George Wilklow to Hillsboro on 3rd trip will continue over Rt. 690 south to Rt. 718 and turn around and follow Rt. 690 to Rt. 7 and to Hillsboro School.

Bus No. 32 to Banneker School will have an auxiliary bus this yeara 12 passenger bus transferred from another route. The new bus will bear the number 51.

The new description of the 2 routes is as follows:

Bus Route No. 32-Driver Mr. Alexander W. Brown

Start at junction of Rt. 50 and Rt. 611 east on Rt. 50 to Middleburg Recreation Center. Receive elementary pupils from Bus No. 26. West on Rt. 50, right on Rt. 11, right on Rt. 7hh to Banneker School. Pick up high school pupils on Rt. 50 and transfer to No. 26. Operate as express bus from Middleburg to Banneker School.

Trip No. 2-Return to Middleburg, west on Rt. 50 and right on Rt. 611, right on Rt. 7hh to Banneker School.

Bus Houte No. 51--Driver Mr. Hack Bushrod

Start at Dishman's Corner, intersection of Rt. 611 and Rt. 626, east on Rt. 626, left on Rt. 745, right on Rt. 733, right on Rt. 734, right on Rt. 748, right on Rt. 50 to Middleburg Recreation Center. right on Rt. 748, right on Rt. 50 to Middleburg Recreation Center. right on Rt. 748, right on Rt. 50. Leave Middleburg on Transfer high school pupils to Bus No. 26. Leave Middleburg on Rt. 626, east on Rt. 733, straight shead on Rt. 734 to Banneker School.

Trip No. 2-Return to Benton to pick up elementary pupils, if necessary to avoid overload on Trip 1.

The time of these two routes will be about the same as last year except that pupils on Rt. 626 should meet Bus 51 about 20 minutes earlier than last year.

While the Loudoun County High School will open at 9:05 instead of 9:15, it is thought that all busses can use the same time schedulefor arrival at this school.

High School Pupils in Town of Leesburg may use busses No. 17, 18, and 28 from Leesburg Elementary School to High School. A second stop will be arranged later.

School bus No. 2 will go over routes 662, 707 and 704 instead of going over route 7 between Clark's Gap and Hamilton and will make a trip to Jones' Garage at Brownsville to pick up children on route 7. School bus No. 19 will make a second trip south of Round Hill to pikk up children heretofore hauled by bus No. 31. Bus No. 31 will discontinue a trip to Round Hill and will add to its route south of Purcellville the following: Start at Silcott Springs, go west on 725, left on 735, left on 734, straight on 728 and left on 690, but pick up only children on 690 that were picked up last year.
