You will please read the enclosed letter a part of which replies to my inquiry about the insurance of certain school pupils. You will note that the teacher in charge left before school closed and the principal seems to know substantially nothing. I believe you will find it to be the case that each one who had insurance collected the money from the insurance company.
