Supply Company of Harpers Ferry was accepted.

The superintendent was authorized to employ a carpenter and helper for a limited period beginning July 1 to repair furniture and make other minor repairs to various school buildings in the county.

The statement submitted by Wilbur C. Hall showing the payments for various school buildings sold and the costs connected therewith was approved as submitted.

The superintendent reported that all school buildings which had been sold were paid for in full and the money had been placed in the hands of the county treasurer.

Attention was called to the fact that the school board would be required to elect its officers annually hereafter, and that the next annual election would take place at the regular July meeting.

The superintendent reported that Miss Louella Brown had declined to accept her teaching position at Lovettsville. The board transferred Miss Katherine Bridges to Waterford and Miss Emma Clemens to Ashburn.
