

WHEREAS, the County School Board of Loudoun County, Virginia, a body corporate of the Commonwealth of Virginia, in the year 1941 built and erected on a tract of land containing eight (8) acres, more or less, the Douglass High School, on the South side of Highway Route No. 7, about one-half mile East of the town of Leesburg in Loudoun County, Virginia; and,

WHEREAS, the School Board believes that it is necessary to build an addition to the said school in order to accommodate the increased number of pupils in attendance; and,

WHEREAS, the School Board is of the opinion that the public interest demands that additional land be acquired for the purpose of enlarging the school facilities at Douglass High School; and,

WHEREAS, the School Board believes that the public interest demands that certain lands owned by L. W. Parker lying immediately West of the school property be acquired for the accomplishment of the purposes aforesaid; and,

WHEREAS, the said land of L. W. Parker which the School Board believes it necessary to acquire is not improved by dwellings or other buildings; and,

WHEREAS, the lands on which the Douglass High School is located and the lands of L. W. Parker which the School Board believes should be acquired for the purposes aforesaid do not contain in the aggregate more than thirty acres; and,

WHEREAS, representatives of the School Board have contacted the owner and have requested that he put a price on the said land, but no agreement has been reached for the purchase of said land consisting of Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 containing approximately 109,530 square feet, lying immediately West of Douglass High School property, said lots being designated on plat made by James A. McWhorter, Surveyor, dated April, 1950, and recorded in Plat Book No. 2, page 141, in the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court of Loudoun County, Virginia, and being a portion of the

land purchased by the said L. W. Parker from Bruce McIntosh and others by deed dated the 30th day of November, 1945, and of record in the Clerk's Office aforesaid in Deed Book 12 C's, Page 353; and

WHEREAS, the School Board is of the opinion that said land is needed and that the public interest demands that the said five lots containing approximately 109,530 square feet, be acquired from the said L. W. Parker for the purpose of enlarging the Douglass High School facilities as aforesaid.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County School Board of Loudoun County, Virginia, a body corporate of the Commonwealth of Virginia, that L. W. Parker be and he hereby is offered the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) for the five several lots containing approximately 109,530 square feet, hereinbefore described, to be conveyed to the County School Board of Loudoun County, Virginia, a body corporate, by a general warranty deed and the title to be free and clear of all liens and encumbrances, and if the said L. W. Parker does not accept this offer by 12:00 o'clock Noon Monday, December 15, 1952, the School Board will consider that said offer is rejected.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the public interest demands and that it is necessary that the said five several lots of land containing approximately 109,530 square feet owned by L. W. Parker be acquired for school purposes by the County School Board of Loudoun County, Virginia, a body corporate, in order to provide adequate and necessary school facilities for the pupils of Loudoun County, Virginia.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that O. L. Emerick, Division Superintendent of Schools for Loudoun County, Virginia, be and he hereby is authorized and directed to submit to the said L.W. Parker the offer to purchase said lands as contained in this resolution by

letter and to forward with his letter a copy of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Ruth M. Emerick, Clerk of this School Board, be and she hereby is instructed and directed to transmit to O. L. Emerick, Division Superintendent of Schools of Loudoun County, Virginia, five certified copies of this resolution.
