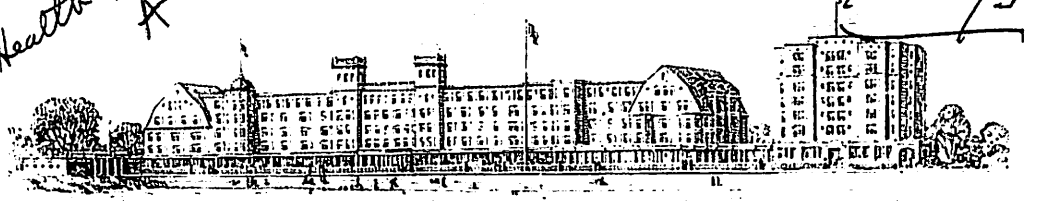

Dear Doctor:

_____ has been examined with an individual pure-tone audiometer. We are enclosing a copy of the audiogram.

Although this test was done under less than ideal conditions, we feel that it is a fairly accurate representation of the child's hearing.

The test was made by air-conduction with the opposite ear occluded by a dummy ear phone. Reasonable precautions were made to secure a quiet room.
