TO TEACHERS.

THIS REGISTER has been prepared with special reference to use in the public schools of Virginia, and has been made to conform, as far as practicable, to the reports which the teachers are required to make to the school officers.

From the Daily and Term Records, if they have been properly kept, teachers can readily make up their Monthly and Term Reports to County Superintendents.

The headings of the columns for marking attendance have reference to the day of the *school* month, and not the calendar month. The small blank squares at the head of these are intended for the initial letters of the days of the week.

Teachers are advised to keep the Daily Records on a separate sheet of paper, and to transfer them to the Register at the close of each day, and especially should this be done during the first week or two of the session.

Before making any entries in the Register read carefully the directions given below.

DIRECTIONS.

1. **Fill up the Heading Carefully.**—The blank before *School*, both in the heading and in the label on the back of the Register, should be filled with a word indicating the color of your school—*white or colored*.

2. **How to Enter Names of Pupils.**—Enter names of pupils in alphabetical order, writing surnames first, and giving christian names in full. Enter the names of the boys first, and leave at least one blank line between the sexes.

3. **Age of Pupils.**—Enter in the proper column, opposite the name of each pupil, the age completed on last birth-day.

4. **How to Indicate Attendance.**—To show that a pupil is present put the figure one (1) in the blank space opposite the name. The space left blank will indicate absence. The sum of these figures, opposite any name for a month, will show the total number of days the pupil was present during the month.

5. **How to Find Average Daily Attendance.**—To find average daily attendance of the boys, divide the number of days all the boys were present at school by the number of days the school was taught. Find average daily attendance of the girls in the same way.

6. **How to Find Percentage of Attendance.**—To find percentage of attendance of the boys, multiply the average daily attendance of the boys by 100, and divide the product by the number of boys. Find percentage of attendance of the girls in the same way. To find total percentage of attendance, multiply the total average daily attendance by 100, and divide the product by the whole number of pupils.

7. **Days Present at School.**—The sum of the numbers, in column headed "Total Days Present," showing number of days each boy was present during the month, will be the proper number to be entered for "Boys," in summary showing "Days Present at School." And the sum of the numbers showing the number of days each girl was present during the month will be the correct number to be entered for "Girls," in the same summary.

8. **How to Find Average Age of Pupils.**—To find average age of the boys, divide the sum of the ages of the boys by the number of boys. Find average age of the girls in the same way. To find total average age, divide the sum of the ages of all the pupils by the total number of pupils.

9. **How to Find Average Monthly Enrollment.**—To find average monthly enrollment of the boys, add the figures showing the number of boys on the roll each month, and divide the sum by the number of months the school was taught. (The divisor in this case should always be a whole number, and should exactly equal the number of monthly reports made to the County Superintendent). Find average monthly enrollment of girls in the same way.

10. **Make all entries neatly, using good black ink.**
11. **At the end of the Term return Register to the district clerk, and take his receipt.**
12. **Forms for Term Record and Register of pupils begin on pages 46 and 62.**
13. **How to Call the Roll.**—There are several methods of doing this. The following is a very good one: Give each pupil a number, and let him be known by that during the term. At roll-call repeat the numbers instead of the pupils' names, and let each pupil answer as his number is called; or, let the pupils, beginning at number one, announce their names consecutively, the teacher repeating the number for those absent.
14. **The Figures in Parenthesis,** opposite headings in summary, refer to directions on pages 5 and 6.

DIGEST OF THE VIRGINIA SCHOOL LAWS AND REGULATIONS RELATING TO TEACHERS.

By Whom Employed.—Teachers are employed by district boards of trustees, and in all cases they must be employed and contracted with at a regular or called meeting of the board. A teacher cannot be legally employed by a district board unless he holds a certificate of qualification, issued according to law and in full force at the time he is employed.

Written Contract.—Before he enters upon the duties of the school the teacher must have a written contract with the district board; without this he cannot by law enforce payment for his services.

The School Register.—Every teacher must keep the School Register according to form prescribed by the Superintendent of Public Instruction, and at the close of his term of service must return it, in good order, to the clerk of the district board.

Text-Books.—Teachers must require all pupils to be supplied with the text-books prescribed by law, and must not tolerate any others. The enforcement of this rule shall not work to the detriment of the school in the matter of average attendance; *i. e.*, the school shall not be closed for failure to make the legal average if the deficiency has been occasioned by the rejection of pupils for not complying with the law as to the uniformity of text-books. The teacher shall be furnished by the County Superintendent with a copy of the regulations of the Board of Education concerning text-books, and this, together with the price-list, he shall keep posted in his school-room.

Subjects Taught.—In every public school shall be taught orthography, reading, writing, arithmetic, grammar, and geography. The Board of Education has added the teaching of the history of Virginia and of the United States, and physiology and hygiene.

The Higher Branches must not be taught except by authority of the district board, and under no circumstances must they be allowed to interfere with the regular and efficient instruction in the elementary studies. In schools taught by one teacher not less than five hours each day shall be given exclusively to instruction in the elementary branches.

Pupils Over Twenty-one Years of Age.—Teachers must not enroll any person over twenty-one years of age who does not present a written permit from the district board. All such pupils are required to submit to the same rules as the other pupils.

Reports to County Superintendents.—Teachers must make Monthly and Term Reports to the County Superintendent of Schools, according to forms furnished. The Monthly Report must be sent to him within three days after the close of the school month, and the Term Report within three days after the close of the school term.

May Suspend Pupils.—Teachers may suspend pupils for sufficient cause until the case has been decided by the district board.

Opening and Closing School.—The time for opening and closing school is regulated by the district board, subject to the approval of the County Superintendent, but no school shall be taught less than six hours each day.

Not to be Book-Agents.—A teacher of a public school cannot act as agent for any publisher of school books, or directly or indirectly receive any gift, emolument, reward, or promise of

reward for using his influence to secure the adoption of any book. This does not prohibit the teacher from serving as the medium of transfer between the dealer and the pupils without pay, or from purchasing books with his own money and keeping them on hand for the convenience of scholars.

Exemption.—Teachers are exempt from serving on juries and from military service in time of peace, during vacation as well as during the school term.

Contagious Diseases.—Persons suffering with contagious diseases shall be excluded from the public schools while in that condition, and no pupils shall be admitted unless they have been vaccinated, unless this clause shall have been suspended by the school board of the county or city.

School Month.—“The school month shall consist of four weeks of five school days each, and deduction shall be made from the pay of teachers for every day they lose, except such days as shall have been declared holidays by district boards.”

Teachers' Certificates—County and city certificates shall state the branches upon which the holder has been examined, and shall be of three grades, according to the ratio of correct answers of each applicant, and other evidence of qualification appearing from the examination, together with the Superintendent's information and knowledge of the applicant's successful experience as a teacher. The first grade certificate will continue in force for a term of three years, and may be renewed for any period not exceeding two years. The second grade certificate will continue in force for a term of two years, and the third grade for one year.

Age.—All applicants for examination for a license to teach in the public schools must be at least eighteen years old.

Admission of Pupils Living Outside the School District.—Pupils living outside a school district may be admitted to the schools of that district by previous arrangement between the school boards of the two districts.
