Recent appropriations of the Federal Government have made available more funds to the State of Virginia, for aid to the crippled and sub-normal children and also adults. The object is to help get defects corrected and to train individuals to be self-supporting.

A survey is now being made through all of the schools of Loudoun County to ascertain the names and conditions of children and adults. Defects include crippled, defective vision, defective hearing, defective speech, organically defective, mentally incompetent, mentally subnormal, and epileptic.
