In a series of newspaper articles to be published in our three local papers beginning this week, I am trying to tell our people about our high schools.

In the fifth or sixth of the series I want to tell whatever readers might be still following me, something about the high school situation in other counties of Northern Virginia, going as far South as Albemarle.

I shall be deeply appreciative if you will write me the following information, but only for white schools:

1. Do you now have 12 grades in your system?
2. If not when do you expect to have 12 grades?
3. How many high schools do you now have and give the number accredited, qualified and certified?
4. If you consolidated all high schools into one for all of the county or the major portion, please state when the building was first used, and how many pupils are now enrolled.
5. If you now have more than one white high school, please give full particulars of any plan for consolidation, or for the construction of a new building or buildings and indicate the progress of any such plans, such as decision by the school board, approval by the board of supervisors, approval by voters of a bond issue, etc.

If you have more than one county, please give information for both.

I shall be very grateful for your assistance.
