

ized by a Special Act of the Assembly which was approved in March 1922. The actual cost of the building as contracted for by the school board is \$18,652.50. The town authorities have shown commendable co-operation with the school authorities in that they have opened a street at the north side of the lot and have built a walk along this and made plans to build a walk along the street leading north from the school property.

The school has shown a steady and rapid growth with only a few back slides. It was a one-teacher school from 1884 to 1894, a ~~xxx~~ two-teacher school from 1894 to 1910 except there were three teachers in 1902-03 when J. D. Harris was principal, a three-teacher school from 1910 to 1916, a four-teacher school from 1916 to January 1923, and a five-teacher school since January 1923.

The number of children has now reached a live monthly enrollment of 153.
