I appeal to the Loudoun County School Board, I appeal in all sincerity to rebuild the school on the old site in Lincoln where the first model High School was erected in Loudoun County. The community where no sacrifice is too great for them to make when it pertains to the High School. Where time and money are of no value when education is to be considered.
