Beginning at A a set stone, corner of Isaac Vandevanter on the south side of the road to Leesburg thence with said Vandevanter S $47^{\circ}$ W 12.43 ch to B a corner to said Vandevanter and myself on the south side of the road thence S $66^{\circ}\frac{3}{4}$ W 7.00 chains to C, a point in the road about 7 feet south of the north line thereof, thence S $84^{\circ}\frac{1}{2}$ W 5.11 chains to D a point in said road about 7 feet from the north line thereof, thence N $88^{\circ}\frac{1}{2}$ W 3.50 chains to E, a stake in the north line of said road and a line of Mrs. George Rhodes, thence with Mrs. George Rhodes N $9^{\circ}\frac{1}{2}$ E 15.32 chains to F, a corner of said Mrs. George and Joseph Rhodes thence with Mrs. Joseph Rhodes S80 E 7.81 chs to G, a corner to the same, thence S $21^{\circ}\frac{3}{4}$ E 0.32 chains to H, a set stone corner to the same, thence S $80^{\circ}\frac{1}{2}$ E 11.00 chs to I, a corner to the same, thence N 80 E 2.50 chs. to K, a corner to the same in the road to Leesburg, thence S $47^{\circ}\frac{1}{2}$ E 0.47 chs. to the beginning containing 22A - 0 R - 7P.
