----- PROPOSED PLAN FOR EQUALIZATION OF TEACHERS' SALARIES -----

We propose;

- A- that in 1941-1942 the colored teachers be paid for twelve months at the now existing monthly salary.
- B- that in 1942-1943 the colored teachers be paid fifty percent of the remaining differential between the white and colored teachers salaries.
- C- that in 1943-1944 a single salary schedule be adopted for both colored and white teachers.
