Be it resolved:

That the Judge of the Circuit Court be hereby requested to appoint Chas. F. Harrison as attorney to examine and approve in writing the title to the lot of land being donated by the Negro citizens of Loudoun County for use as a high school site at Leesburg, and that the said Chas. F. Harrison be hereby designed by this board to make the necessary certificate in connection with the application of this board for a loan of \$30,000 from the State Literary Fund of Virginia for use in erecting a colored high school.

The foregoing resolution is a true excerpt from the minutes of the County School Board at an meeting held at Leesburg, Virginia on December 10, 1940 and recorded on page 144 of the School Board Minute Book Number three,
