IN RE: THE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD OF LOUDOUN COUNTY, VIRGINIA.

This day came the County School Board of Loudoun County, Virginia and exhibited a deed to it from John W. Wanzer et al, Trustees of the County Wide League of Loudoun County, for a tract of land containing eight (8) acres to be used for school purposes for the colored school children of Loudoun County, Virginia, and filed its petition praying that said gift be ordered by this Court accepted by the County School Board of Loudoun County, Virginia and that the title thereto be approved by Charles F. Harrison, Commonwealth Attorney of Loudoun County, Virginia.

On consideration whereof, it appearing that the County School Board of Loudoun County, Virginia desires to borrow \$30,000 from the Literary Fund of the State of Virginia, it is ordered that Charles F. Harrison, Commonwealth Attorney of Loudoun County, Virginia, do examine the title to said tract of land and if approved record a certificate by him of said approval with the aforesaid deed before the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Loudoun County, Virginia, who shall enroll the same on the proper deed book of the land records of Loudoun County, Virginia.
