In accordance with your letter of March 27, you will find below my proposed program of work for the summer months.

1. Maintain office hours for the benefit of pupils and patrons.
2. Complete all records and college transcripts.

4. Contact groups of teachers for suggestions relative to the revision of the hand book.
5. Complete all final reports for both high and elementary schools.
6. Plan with faculty committee for in-service training courses for next season.

8. Set up a library program for next year as we will not have a librarian.
9. Supervise painting and repair of building.
10. General supervision of the entire school plant.

13. Visit homes of pupils when advisable and time permits.
14. Attend summer school part time to complete work on my Master's Degree.

15. Operate a summer school if demand is sufficient.
16. Supervise coach classes if any are held.
