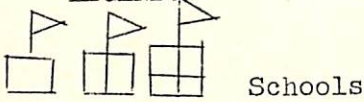

(5) Miles between arrow points

$\frac{2}{7} - \frac{8}{8-11}$ Two pupils in 7th grade - 8 pupils in grades 8 - 11. For the Alpha Route the data tell that the Jones School enrolls 70 pupils in grades 1 - 6, inclusive. The bus approaches the school with 30 pupils for grades 1 - 11 and passes the school with the load described above.

The short perpendicular line indicates where the bus begins to take on pupils for the next school.
