COMPARATIVE STATISTICS ON RURAL AND URBAN SCHOOLS.

Rural as Used here means population living on farms and in villages below 2500.

Enrollment. In the Rural Schools (elementary and secondary) are found:

53 percent of the pupils of the U.S.
58 " of the teachers of the U.S.

Elementary School Figures. In rural communities (farms and places below 2500) are found:

57 percent of the entire elementary school enrollment
64 percent of the elementary teachers
91 percent of the elementary schools, of which
 161,531 are one-teacher schools
 20,135 are two-teacher schools
 16,291 are consolidated schools

Secondary School Figures. In rural communities are found:

29 percent of the entire secondary school enrollment
36 percent of the secondary teachers
78 percent of the secondary schools
25.7 percent of the rural (children 15-18 years of age)
71.7 percent of the urban () are in secondary schools
4.6 percent of rural (children enter
12.8 percent of urban (college

School Term. The average length of the school term is:
Rural 156 days. Urban 183 days

Cost per Pupil. The total per pupil cost based on average daily attendance is: Rural \$75.01 2/3 Urban \$129.82 *averaging*

Value of School Property. The average value of school property per pupil enrolled is:

1908 Rural \$99 Urban \$299. *8 times more*

Salaries. The average salary of all teachers, supervisors and principals is:

Rural \$855. Urban \$1,878.

Teacher-Training. 154 or 83 percent of the 185 State normal schools and teachers colleges in the U. S. offer special courses in Rural education or otherwise differentiate their work for prospective rural teachers.

County superintendents are still elected by popular vote in 25 states. State superintendents in 34 states. Professional supervisors for rural schools are employed in only 14 states.

Result of small H.L. 95% are fewer than 100.
