# Court Asked to Block Funds For Loudoun School Site

LEESBURG, Va., April 21.—An injunction to prevent payment for the site selected for the new Loudoun County consolidated high school, has been applied for in Warren County Circuit Court by five Purcellville residents.

The action is directed against the Loudoun County School Board, School Supt. O. L. Emrick and Treasurer S. Reed Galleher.

The injunction application states that the \$15,000 to be paid for the site is an excessive price, the land is not suitable, the location is not in the geographical center of the county and that the "board exceeded its authority and acted corruptly."

A second protest of the decision to purchase the lot was received yesterday. It was signed by six Lovettsville residents, and they, too, said the School Board "exceeded its authority and acted corruptly."
