

Report of Survey made May 19th 1909.

J. P. Brown To McViead School District by direction of Wm. J. Smith and Walter Brown of a tract of Land near to and North of the Village of Lincoln in Loudoun County Virginia. bounded as follows, viz:-
Beginning in a line of E. Rawson heirs in east drain of road leading from Lincoln to Purcellville, at A a corner to J. P. Brown marked by a planted stone on the side of road 7 links distant in line of survey. Then bearing with said Arrow in three lines viz:- N. 75° E 10.50 chs to a planted stone B. Then N 36° W 10.62 chs. to a planted stone C. Then through the woods S 75° W 9.60 chs. to D, near middle of road, marked by a planted stone 23 links distant in said line and on east side of road.
Then S 30° E 2.54 chs to an iron pin near middle of said road, at E. Then S 31½° E 7.81 chs to A the beginning.
