The county school board of Loudoun County, by its attorneys this day appeared in court and moved the Court to correct its order heretofore entered in this cause at the present term of this court, which motion the counsel for the appellant resisted.

And whereupon the Court granted the motion of the said county school board, so as to show that the motion of said board was to dismiss the appeal and the petition of the appellant and that the said board did not move to remand this case to the county trustee electoral board as set out in set order but the Court remanded said case of its own motion to which action of the court in remanding said case, the said county school board objected and except as to the action of said court, in dismissing the said appeal the said board objects to the opinion of the court as set in said order, especially that portion of said opinion holding "that the action of the County School Board of April 10, 1926, as shown by said petition was appealable to the Trustee Electoral Board".
